"We published the first State of Scrum report in 2013, and it's a very popular benchmark report. Those interested in Scrum simply want unbiased data about who is using Scrum, why, and how, and that's what we deliver in this report," explains Scrum Alliance Managing Director Carol McEwan.

The purpose of the State of Scrum report is to track trends in Scrum related to who is currently practicing Scrum, the key motivators for adopting Scrum, and how Scrum is actually being practiced. Data is collected via an online survey and taps into project management and Agile communities around the world. In the 2013 State of Scrum report, 70 different countries were represented by more than 500 survey participants.
